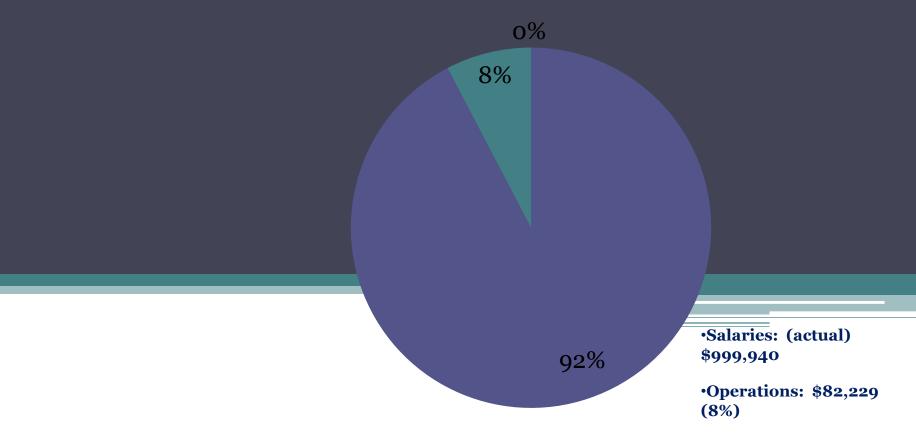
County Attorney's Office staffing levels 2004 - 2015

- County Attorney's office has "expanded" by two attorneys in the eleven years*
- 2004 to 2012 8 FTE's –5 attorneys and 3 staff
 - ➤ 2009 CAT assumed all civil litigation defense and legal risk management in house
 - ► 2012 litigation attorney *via* interdepartmental transfer of funds
- 2012 2014 9 FTE's –6 attorneys and 3 FT staff
- 2015 10 FTE's 7 attorneys and 3 FT staff
 EPSO assigned in-house counsel to CAT—EPSO brought a workload of 1.5 attorneys*

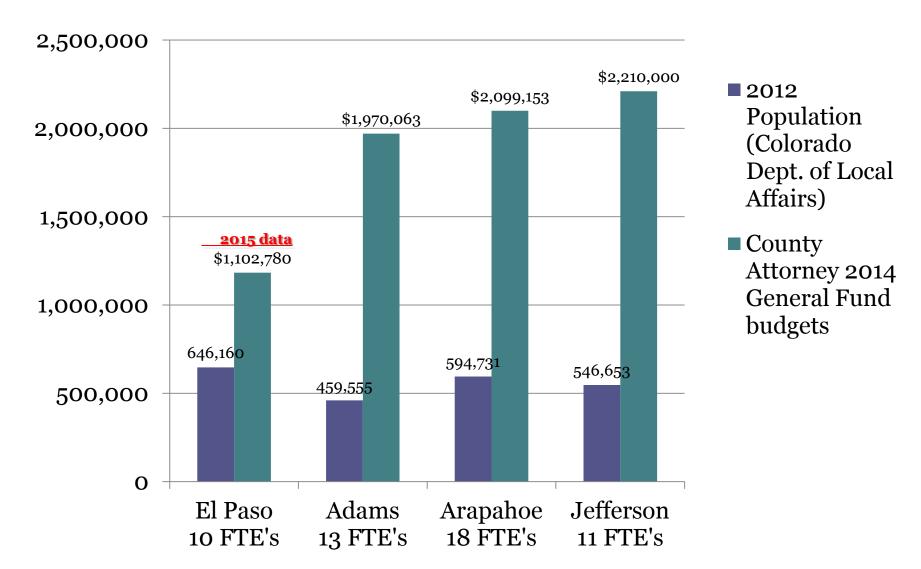
CAT CIVIL budget breakdown



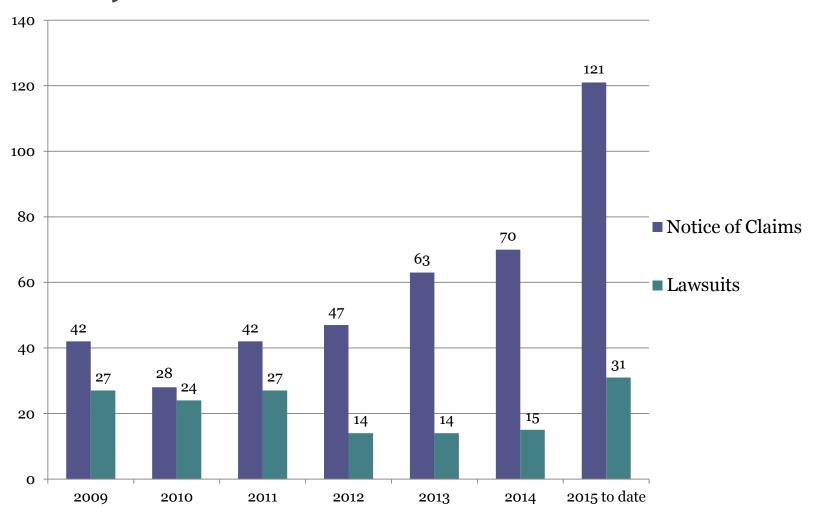
Operations budget - breakdown of major categories:

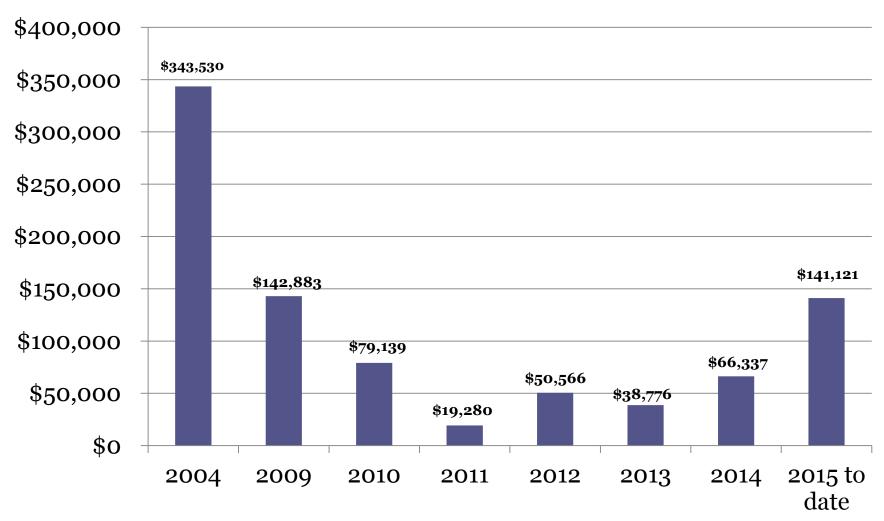
31 CURRENT CASES— UP FROM 9 LAST YEAR
