

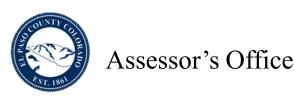

Assessor's Office Strategic Plan Goals:

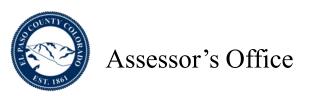

 - 21 Administrative Staff

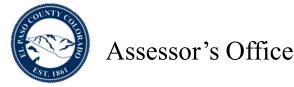

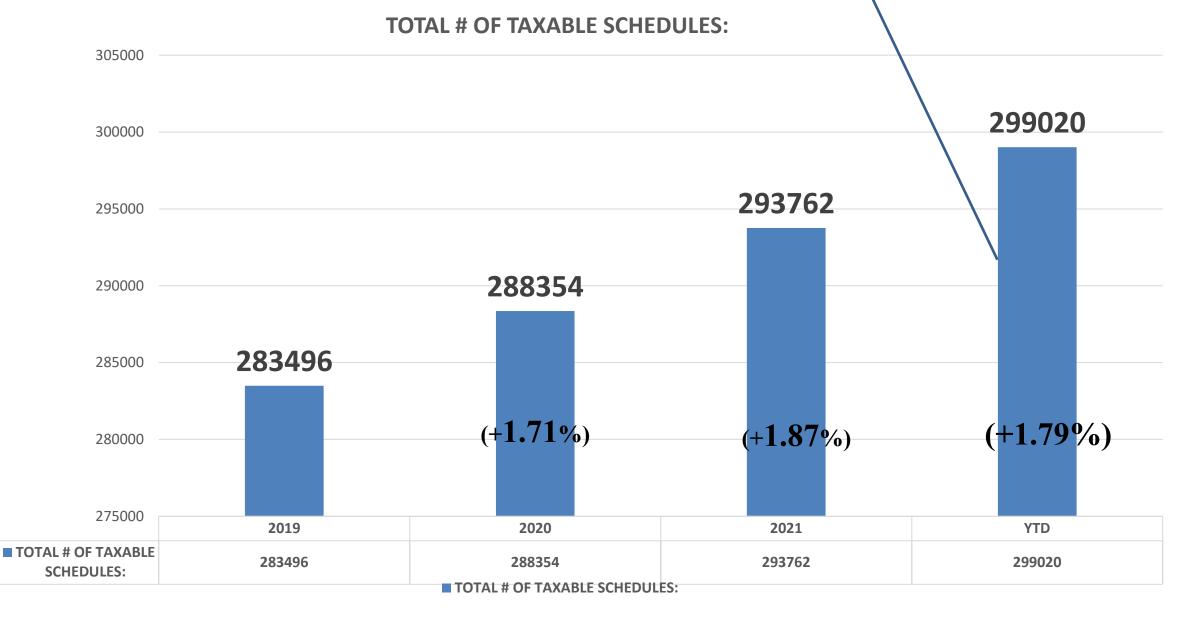
- 293,762 Total Taxable Schedules

 - 4,464 (2.233%) Disabled Veteran Property Tax Exemption



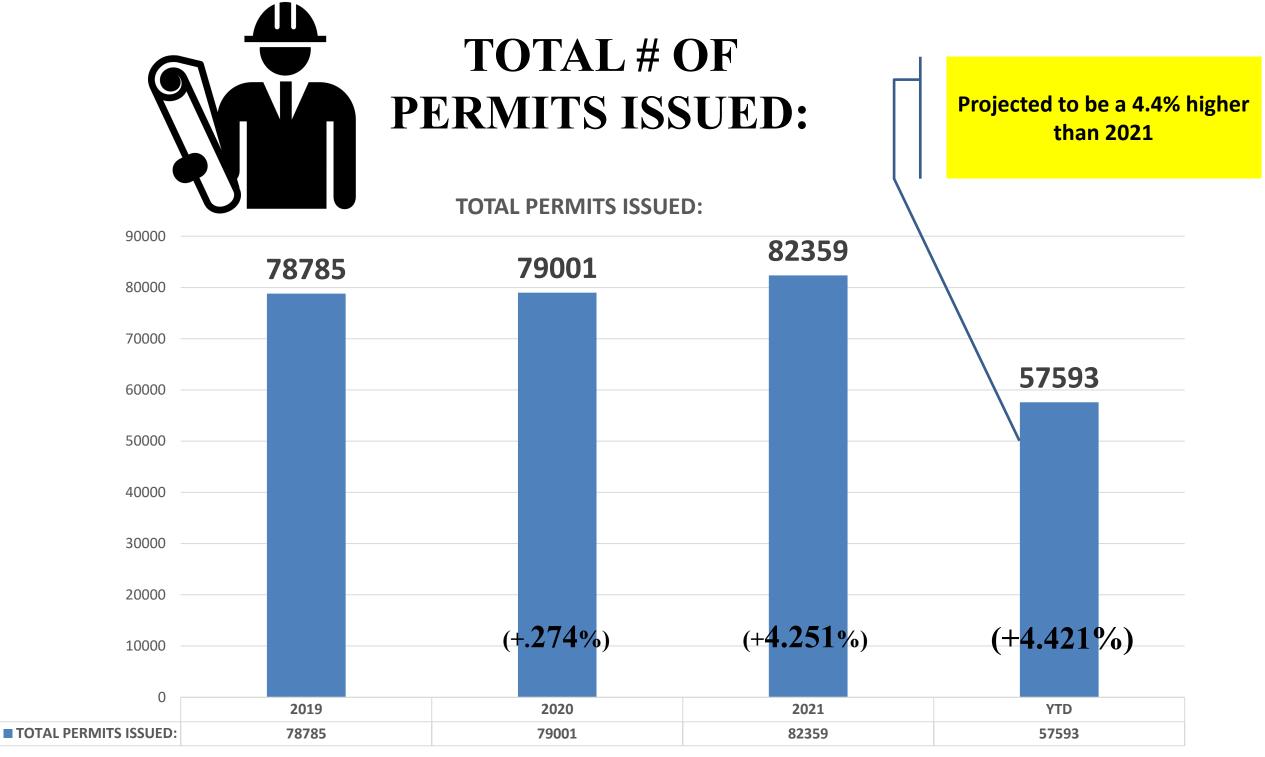

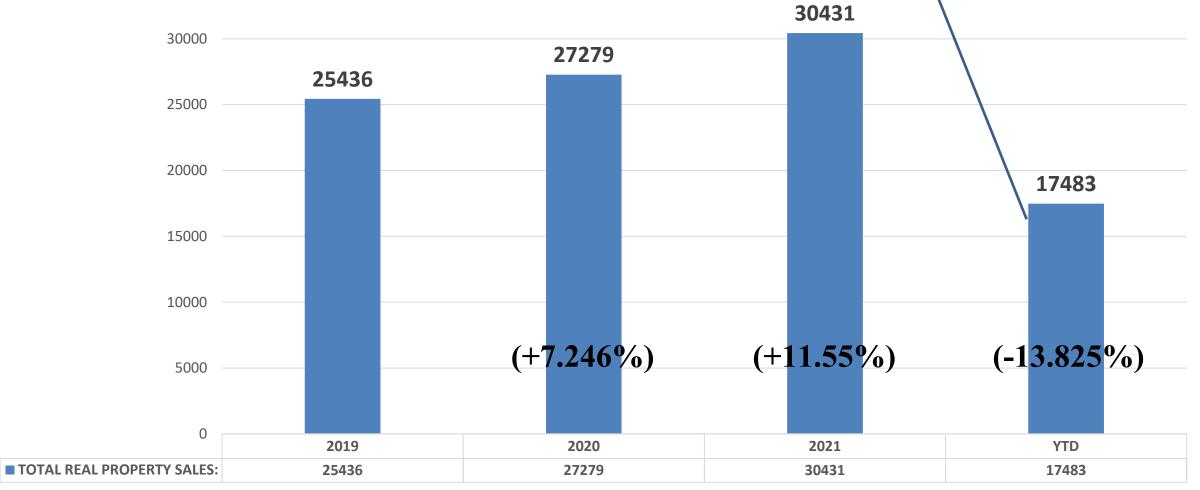
TOTAL PERMITS ISSUED:

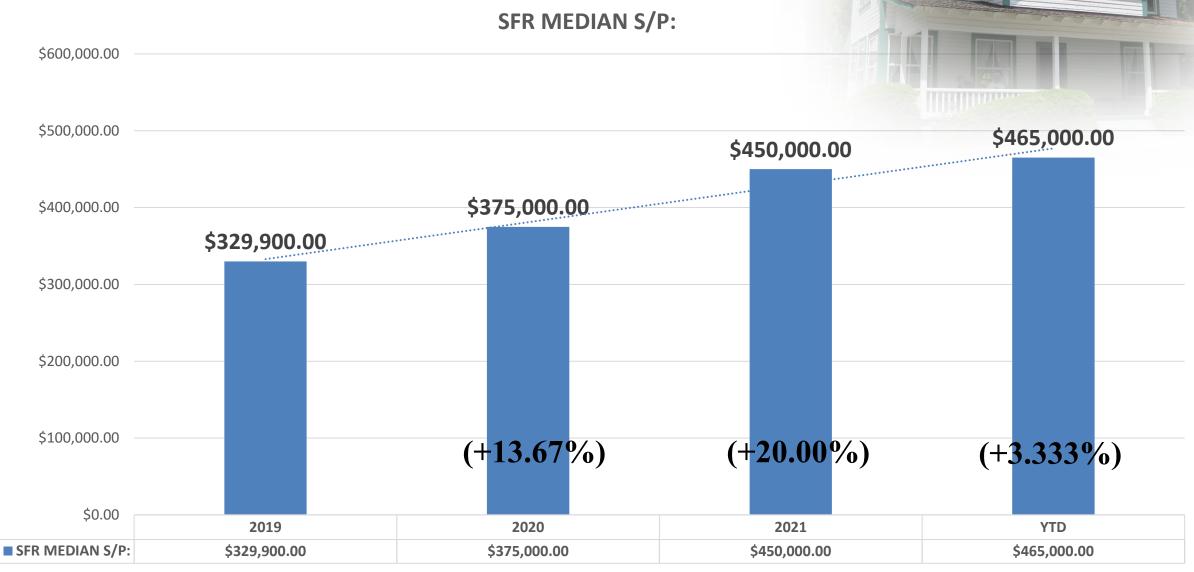

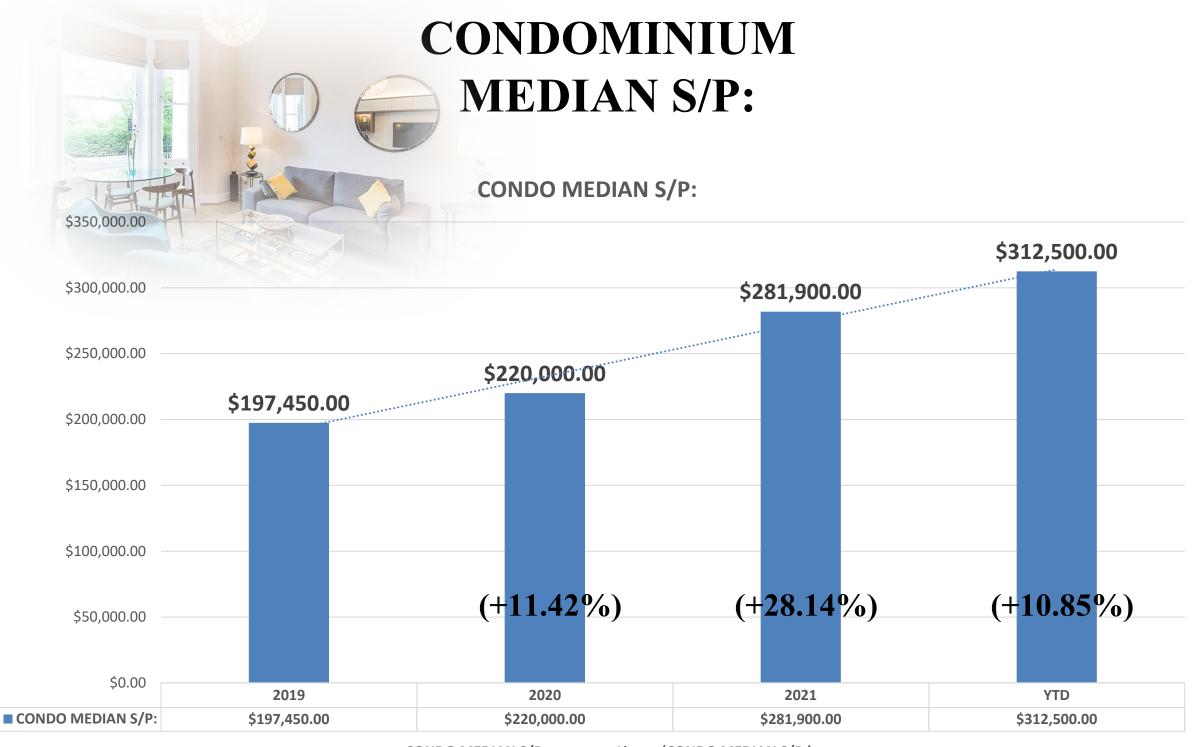

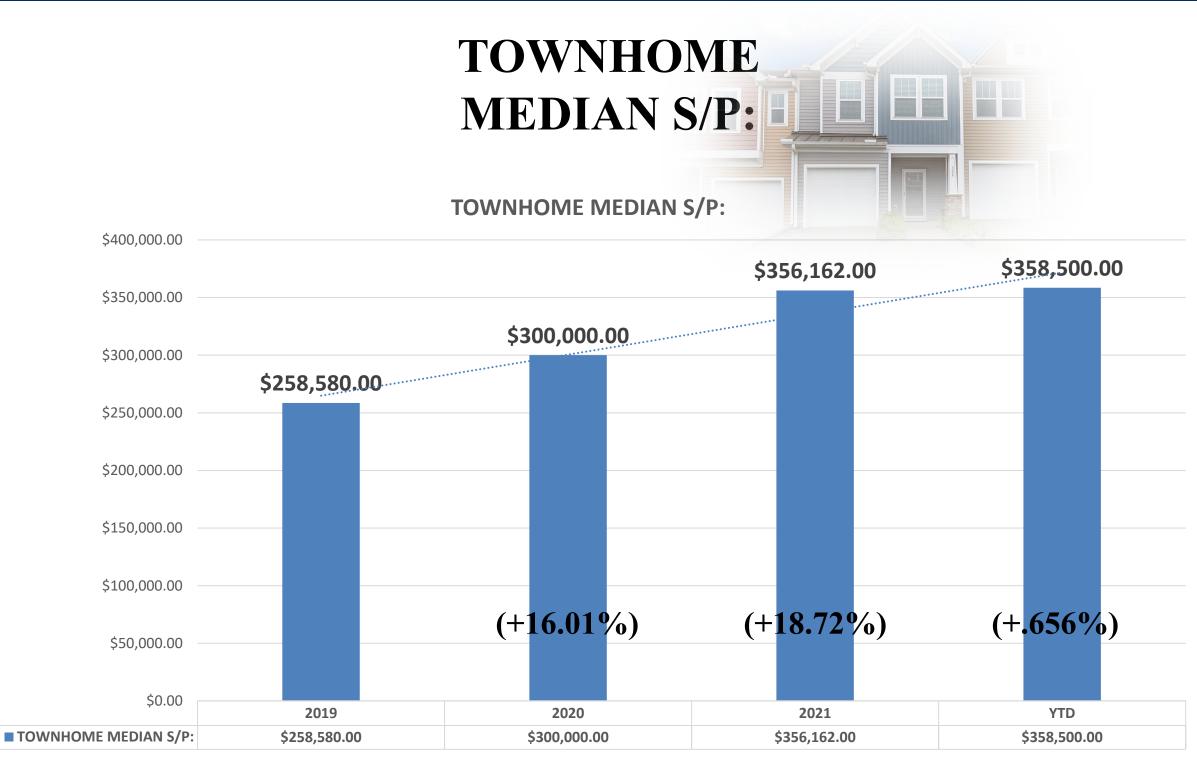
SFR MEDIAN S/P: Linear (SFR MEDIAN S/P:)





CONDO MEDIAN S/P: Linear (CONDO MEDIAN S/P:)





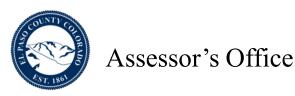
TOWNHOME MEDIAN S/P: Linear (TOWNHOME MEDIAN S/P:)

- Total 2022 Assessor Budget = \$4,248,132
 - Total 2022 Salaries & Wages = \$3,939,294 (92.730%)
 - Total 2022 Operations = \$308,838 (7.270%)

Assessor Critical Needs and Justification

Requesting \$50,000 to base Operations Budget for postage and paper.

Yearly Notice of Value & Declaration Schedule Printing and Mailing:

- Seen an increase of 12.637% of taxable schedules over the past seven years.
- In 2014, postage rates were .49 cents per letter. Today, that rate is .60 cents, which is a 22.44% increase over a seven-year period.
- Paper and printing has increased 11% over this past year. Normal year-by-year increases is less than 1-3% per year.

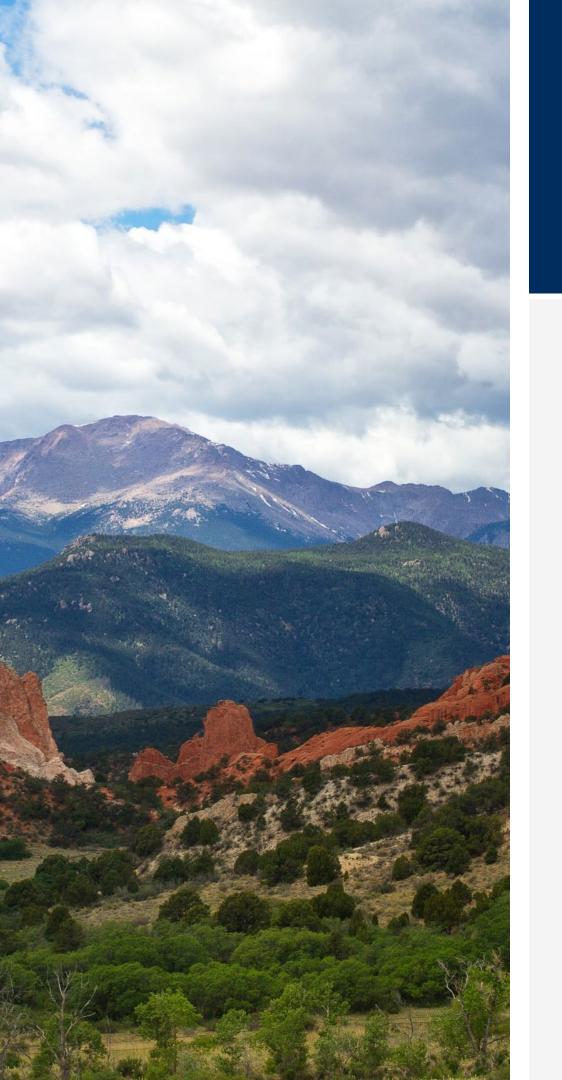
